

# MUNICIPAL INFORMATIVE BULLETIN

## AYUNTAMIENTO DE LLÍBER

### **1.- Closing budgets for years 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011.**

The Town Hall has continued with the closing of the municipal budgets for the years 2008 to 2011. Failure to close said accounts has resulted in the Town Hall not receiving funds due from the State, and therefore the present Corporation has given priority to the preparation of the accounts to be able to close these fiscal years.

### **2.- Approval of the plan to pay suppliers.**

The Plan of Adjustment for Llíber Town Hall to pay suppliers was approved at the Council meeting held on 30 March 2012. Thanks to the approval of this plan, the State has granted a loan of 578.907.73 € to Llíber Town Hall, with duration of ten years to pay in total all outstanding bills from suppliers, the aim of the Corporation being to pay the old debts owed to suppliers. The town Hall will repay the loan in quarterly instalments, of 8.786,34€ until May 2014 and following this date quarterly instalments of 18.090,87€ until May 2022.

On the part of the State, in order to have this plan of adjustment approved, Llíber Town Hall was obliged to increase its income to repay the loan. Accordingly, at the Council Meeting held on 18 July 2012, modification of the bylaws with regard to increases in IBI and the tax for construction, modification and building works was approved.

### **3.- Approval of the plan to identify the debt owed to the Mancomunidad Val de Pop in order to pay for the collection of urban solid waste.**

On 16 January 2013 the Town Council authorised the Mayor to put forward a proposal to the Mancomunidad Val de Pop to deal with the debt owed by Llíber for rubbish collection. This debt is the consequence of non payment for years 2010 and 2011 and the amount owed is 130.517.33€ plus interest. At the meeting held on 28 January 2013 the Mancomunidad accepted the proposal of the Town Hall. The agreed amount will be paid monthly during the years 2013 and 2014, 4.600€ per month in 2013 and 6.600€ per month in 2014. Payment of interest will be made in 2015.

### **4.- Sentence regarding air conditioning system for the Social Centre.**

In the month of February 2012 the Town Hall was notified of the sentence going back to ordinary process 1214/2009. By virtue of this sentence the Town Hall must pay the amount of 40.554,11€, being principal and interest also original amount of 10.000€ in concept of costs. The aforesaid sentence blames the Town Hall for not paying the company Jujuju Aquacenter S.L. for the air conditioning system for the Llíber Social Centre. The cost of these installations rose to 29.980,18€, for which the Town Hall had received a grant from the Diputación in the year 2003, but this was not paid due to an alleged malfunction of the system. The company started civil proceedings in 2009 and the judge, pronouncing sentence rejected the claim of the Corporation of Llíber, and for which now the Town Hall must pay practically double the original cost of the system, the previous Corporation having diverted the grant money for other purposes despite the fact that legally the grant could only be used for the purpose of the air conditioning system.

### **5.- Works.**

A grant of 11.152,89€ from the Diputación has enabled the reform of the childrens park / playground adjoining the Saints Cosme and Damian school.

The Diputación has also provided a grant of 225.400€ for upgrading and surfacing the following roads: Access road to La Definitiva Well (Zone Cuta), Camino del Remolí, Camino del Rio (zone Jardins), Calle la Luna (Pueblo), Calle san Pedro (Pueblo).

## **6.-Grants.**

Llíber Town Hall has received the following grants approved by the Diputacion of Alicante:

19.384,75€ for purchase and new motor for the Definitiva Well.

11.758,90€ for removal of pump and installing new pump for the Definitiva Well.

2.000€ to cover costs – Patron Saints Fiestas.

1.500€ for kitchen equipment for the Pensioner´s Centre.

1.600 € for computer equipment.

600€ for costs of the “Convivencia” events held between the elderly persons and foreign residents (JOMA).

5.000€ for hire of lighting.

33.250€ to adapt street lighting to energy efficient.

1.500€ for maintenance of the school dining room, school year 2011/2012.

42.518,51€ for modifications to water supply zone Morterets.

1.500€ for first walk BTT Llíber – Cau 2012.

950€ for musical performance of La Canya – dolçainer y tabalet.

1.725€ for Social Services.

1.700€ for performances of economic character.

1.100€ for air conditioning equipment.

1.900€ for children´s theatre performance August 2012.

6.650€ for heating Social Centre year 2012.

2.000€ for furniture (tables and chairs).

Total sum of all grants mentioned is 373.190,05€, including those referred to in the previous point. Non financial grant received - for supply and installation of 10 waste paper bins and 5 benches in the village.

## **7.- Grant for water supply to Morterets.**

As mentioned in the previous point, a grant for modification to the water supply for Morterets has been received. This it is hoped will provide a definitive solution to the problem of supply experienced in this area during the summer months.

## **8.- Medical Centre.**

The Town Hall, in cooperation with Conselleria de Sanidad and Marina Salud has computerized the Llíber Medical Centre, giving direct connection to the health service network. This gives the residents of the locality access to the same level of services as the rest of the citizens of the Comunidad. Advantages arising from this include the ability to make appointments by means of the website of Conselleria de Sanitat or by the Town Hall telephone (and at a later date by theTown Hall website), and the doctors are able to access each patients medical history electronically.

## **9.- Llíber as a Touristic Municipality.**

The Council Meeting held on 30 March 2012 approved the declaration of Llíber as a “Municipio Turístico” – village of special tourism interest. One advantage of being considered a village with tourism interest is that Llíber can enter in agreements with the Generalitat for development of tourism.

## **10.- Creation of Local Police Force.**

The Council meeting held on 30 March 2012 approved the creation of a Local Police Force. Without any increased costs to the public finances, designation as a Local Police Force gives access to professional development and materials essential to daily duties and

allowing the officers to carry out their work efficiently in respect of the rights of the citizens and public safety. For this it was considered essential to create the Local Police Force for Llíber.

**11.- New Councillor.**

At the Council Meeting held on 16 January 2013, Dña Maria Vicenta Vives Ivars PSOE took possession of the post of Councillor, vacated by the resignation of Dña Lucia Victoria Marsal.
